Partnership Summary

The Pardee Institute first began working with AUDA-NEPAD in 2012, co-leading IFs training and capacity building sessions with the Institute for Security Studies (ISS). Since then, Pardee has partnered with AUDA-NEPAD to provide analysis and support in pursuing Agenda 2063. Early projects focused on better understanding Africa's long-term future, while recent engagements have directly supported target-setting for the Second Ten-Year Implementation Plan (STYIP) at a continental and country level.

Key Collaborations & Deliverables

2018: Pardee–AUDA-NEPAD collaboration to support Agenda 2063 implementation

- Report producing analysis of long-term transformations underway on the continent, informing investments in pursuit of Agenda 2063, presented at the 32nd African Union Summit
- Reports featuring deep analytical dives on eliminating hunger and the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA)

2020: COVID-19 Impact Foresight

- Report exploring the long-term effects of COVID-19, in collaboration with the ISS
- COVID-19 Africa impact analysis presented to the UNDP Regional Bureau for Africa and at a Chatham House event

2023: Agenda 2063 STYIP

- Use of IFs modeling and collaborative workshops with the AU to develop concrete targets and priorities in the STYIP
- Estimation of the investments and costs required to pursue targets defined in the STYIP
- Model training and capacity building for AUDA-NEPAD staff on the IFs model and STYIP target-setting methodology

2024-25: Ongoing Collaboration

- Capacity building and training in the IFs model for AUDA-NEPAD teams, African governments, and other stakeholders
- Build a framework to downscale targets from the continental level and identify country-specific STYIP targets
